During the first six months of 2025, we will be working to consolidate the Great Southwest and Yucca Council IT resources to accommodate our merger. This will include:

- 1. Creating a single website for the new Council.

- 2. Moving event registrations and management of those events to Blackpug, the event management platform currently used by the Yucca Council.

a. This change will go into effect 1-1-2025. Current registrations and payments already made in Tentaroo for events after this date will be moved for you. b. All events, both North and South, will be open to everyone. Please make sure you check event locations before registering.

RECHARTERING UPDATE

With the calendar turning over to December, hopefully the thoughts of Unit Key 3s are not only on the impending Christmas holiday, but also the annual charter renewal process. While the Great Southwest and Yucca Councils have merged legally and financially, their my.scouting accounts won't be merged until next week. Since we can't provide any numbers on how recharter is going in the new Council, we'll focus on how to have a successful recharter.

With BSA disconnecting individual membership renewal from renewing the unit's charter, the old "recharter" process is now called "Unit Renewal." Unit Renewal has been available since Nov. 1, so we have some experience with how it works. Since it's been disconnected from the membership renewal process, think of the unit renewal process having two phases, Preparation and Renewal/Posting: The new should be quicker and easier, and it can be ... and here are some tips for getting thorough both phases. All directed towards helping us accomplish our goal of finishing the process for all units before the office staff start their holiday breaks later this month.

PREPARATION

- Ensure that Youth Protection Training (YPT) for all adults is current, and will remain current through the end of December 2024. Please note: If someone's YPT has expired and their membership has been Suspended, they won't appear on any rosters. So if someone is missing, or a position is showing as un-filled, check to see if it's due to expired YPT. (As a side note, if a person's membership has been Suspended, they will NOT receive reminders to renew their membership ... and about 90% of council members have their membership expiring in December 2024!)
- Ensure the positions for adult leaders are correct. If not, use the Position Manager function in Organization Manager to update the positions.
- Check to see if your BeAScout 'pin' data is correct. BeAScout pins can be updated via the Unit Pin link in Organization Manager.

RENEWAL/POSTING

When ready to begin the Unit Renewal process, unit Key 3s/Key 3 Delegates need to log into their my.scouting.org accounts, and click on the Organization Manager tool. Once that page loads, they'll see a Unit Renewal option on the left. Unit Renewal will be a short 6-Step process online, and an additional paper-based step:

Online Steps:

- 1. Log into my.scouting and click on Organization Manager.
- 2. Click on the Unit Renewal option.
- 3. Validate the information presented (and fix any issues it may identify such as adults needing YPT, positions that need to be changed, etc). Once all issues are fixed, you'll be taken to a page to validate the unit's Be A Scout "PIN" information.
- 4. Review all PIN-related information to ensure it's correct.
- 5. Person doing Unit Renewal enter their name in the Signature field.
- 6. Pay the annual Charter fee, and click Submit. The fee is \$100.00, and can be paid by ACH, credit card, or at the Council office. For ACH, there's a \$1.00 fee; for credit card, there's a 3% processing fee. There's no charge for any form of payment made at the Council office. Please note that for troops that are part of the "Combined" (i.e., co-ed) troop test, they must renew both the active and hold units. This is in case the unit wants to withdraw from the test, or Scouting America decides to not go forward with combined units. This will ensure there's a unit for them to go back to.

Paper Step

Unit leaders need to complete the annual charter agreement to finish the process. A copy of the form can be found at: <u>https://www.scouting.org/wp-</u> content/uploads/2024/04/BSA-Annual-Charter-Agreement-Charter-Orgs 2024-

<u>2025.pdf</u>. Once a copy of the signed charter agreement form is received, the Council Registrar will post the charter, completing the process!


